










Greenheart Piling & Timbers



With its excellent resistance to attack from marine borers, very high durability, and superior strength properties, greenheart is ideally suited for use under the most demanding conditions. This makes greenheart the number one timber choice for either salt water or fresh water applications.



Greenheart has been used for over 150 years and is undoubtedly the most suitable timber species for marine construction.





Greenheart Piling & Timbers (cont'd)



Greenheart is three to four times stronger than treated pine or fir, and is biologically resistant to marine boring pests and decay. Greenheart's natural preservatives will not dissipate. However, the poisonous chemicals in some treated woods may leach out, damaging the environment and leaving the wood vulnerable to marine organisms.



Extraordinary density along with high bending strength and high crushing strength makes greenheart ideal for heavy structural work. It is commonly used in docks, piers, jetties, pilings, lock gates, wharves, and marinas. Greenheart has been known to last over 50 years without developing any defects.


